- Peri wanted to be sure the projects with significant value and that support the company strategy are prioritized and put into motion across the organization.

- Management reviews the project portfolio in a monthly portfolio board meeting. Various committees prepare the portfolio and the decisions on projects.
- Comprehensive reporting for management was achieved with the Power BI Integration.
